Yishun Community Hospital (YCH), opening in 2015, will cater to the subacute and rehabilitation needs of patients. With over 425 beds, the community hospital will provide intermediate care for patients who do not require the intensive care services of an acute care hospital. YCH will serve the community in the north, where patients can benefit from the integration of the two hospitals in terms of physical proximity, information flow and treatment plans.
